COSTCO VOLUNTEER READING PROGRAM



Refund Policy

To withdraw or cancel a registration, please contact Parks & Recreation Customer Service at 724-779- 4 FUN (4386) . Instructors are not authorized to issue refunds or credits.

Refunds - A refund will be issued if the Parks & Recreation office is notified of the withdrawal at least 7 days in advance of the start date of the class or activity. Refunds are issued by check or credited to a credit card. A processing fee of \$5 is assessed for all cancelled registrations. There are no refunds after the start date of the program.

Credit on Account - If the withdrawal is made 1-7 days prior to the start of the program, a Parks and Recreation credit will be placed on the household account. A processing fee of \$5 per program is assessed for all cancelled registrations.
